

COMMONWEALTH UNIVERSITY OF PA

As of July 1, 2022 Bloomsburg, Lock Haven, and Mansfield universities became Commonwealth University of PA

- Integration of universities took the work of nearly 1,000 individuals over 18 months.
- Single Leadership Team
- Expanded Academic Program Offerings



Agreement signed with Central Columbia School District

• Agreement guarantees admission, eligibility for merit-based scholarships, and oncampus housing at any of its locations



Transfer agreements signed with community colleges

- Agreement guarantees transfer admission for students at Northern Pennsylvania Regional College and Reading Area Community College
- Qualifying students will be eligible for scholarships based on credits earned and GPA



Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board Awards Grant to CU Campuses to Curb Underage Drinking

- Each campus will receive \$40,000 from Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to help curb underage drinking
- Grant money will be used to fund trainings, outreach, presentations, and other resources


Bloomsburg Police Departments and the Town of Bloomsburg Awarded Grant for Training Program

 The Bloomsburg University Police Department partnered with the Town of Bloomsburg Police Department to implement ICAT training for all officers with \$33,000 grant



Bloomsburg Nursing Department Earned CCNE Reaccreditation

 Reaccreditation for Bachelor of Science, Master of Science, and Doctor of Nursing Practice programs for 10 years ending June 30, 2032.



TRIO Upward Bound Program Renewed by U.S. Department of Education

 Program will receive at least \$2.44 million in federal funds to continue preparing low income and potential first-generation college students from 8 area high schools to successfully enroll in and complete postsecondary degree programs.

Mansfield Receives \$25,000 Donation from PSECU


