

Guaranteed Admission and Scholarship Agreements Signed with 50 Local School Districts

- CommonwealthU and 50 school districts in northeastern and central Pennsylvania, have signed agreements guaranteeing admission, eligibility for merit-based scholarships, and oncampus housing at any of its locations.
- Scholarships range up to \$7,000 per year or \$28,000 over four years.



Shawver Named Outstanding Dean

- The University Sales Center Alliance (USCA) named Dr. Todd Shawver, Dean of the Zeigler College of Business, as its 2022 Outstanding Dean.
- The USCA Outstanding Dean Award recognizes a dean who has made significant contributions and demonstrated unwavering support of a USCA member's sales program.



Lock Haven Donates to Haven Cupboard During Hunger Bowl Event

 Lock Haven's Community Service Office hosted its annual Hunger Bowl to benefit the Haven Cupboard campus food pantry. A total of 3,715 food items were donated by 16 clubs and organizations and 810 faculty and staff groups - more than 1,330 items over last year's donation total.





Project Go Grant

- The Army ROTC program at Lock Haven in conjunction with the Languages and Cultures Department, received a \$375,000 Project Global Officer (Project GO) grant for programming in the Russian language for ROTC cadets.
- CU is one of only 12 institutions nationwide to receive the grant which will help promote critical language education, offer domestic and overseas language and cultural immersion, and intercultural exposure to its ROTC cadets through Project GO.



Chemistry and Biology Students to Benefit from Incubator Donation

- Mansfield recently received a donation of four incubators from Corning Incorporated. The incubators were distributed between two labs with Drs. Maegen Borzok, Kristen Long, and Elaine Farkas.
- Dr. Borzok, will use the two incubators in a biochemistry course to introduce students to foundational biochemistry and molecular biology techniques.



Mansfield Marching Band Invited to Perform in London New Year's Day Parade

 The Spirit and the Pride of Pennsylvania -- the Mansfield Marching Band and the Concert Wind Ensemble have been invited to perform in the 2024 London New Year's Day Parade.



Robert and Dolores Lynch Multicultural Resource Center Opens at Lock Haven

- A grand opening for the MRC was part of Lock Haven's homecoming festivities in September.
- The MRC aims to foster healthy relationships and community building on campus by focusing on student success, leadership, and engagement.
- The Center is open to all students and will serve as an inclusive place where students can feel welcome, safe, and respected.



Lock Haven Plants Orchard to Combat Food Insecurity

- Lock Haven biology faculty member Dr. Heather Bechtold, along with biology faculty from two other PASSHE universities, Cem Akin from the Fruit Tree Planting Foundation, and 46 volunteers from across the Lock Haven campus, planted 40 fruit trees to help combat food insecurity on the Lock Haven campus.
- Each orchard contains varieties of apples, plums, sour cherries, and peaches that are all disease and pest resistant,



Lock Haven Students Gain Insight and Networking Opportunity with Pittsburgh Pirates' Executives

- Students from Lock Haven's Sport Management Club recently attended the Pittsburgh Pirates Careers in Sport Night held at PNC Park.
- During the event, the 11 students attended a panel, a resume workshop, and a networking session where they received advice on how to start careers within the industry.
- Experiential learning opportunities outside of the classroom is a main principle of the sport management program at Lock Haven.



Public Safety Training Institute at Mansfield Enters Training Agreement with Fish and Boat Commission

- The Mansfield University Public Safety Training Institute (MUPSTI) have entered into a training agreement with the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC).
- The trainees receive approximately six months of Law Enforcement training as required by the Pennsylvania Municipal Police Training Act, Act 120. The WCO trainees will stay on-campus housing during the duration of their training.




12th Annual ZIPD Business Conference

- The Zeigler College of Business held its 12th annual Zeigler Institute for Professional Development (ZIPD) Conference in November. The theme of the 2022 conference was "Get a Pulse on Professionalism."
- The conference provides students with a professional environment to practice their networking skills and learn from business professionals.
- One highlight included a Mansfield student, and first-time attendee, leaving the event with a job offer.



Commonwealth University Earns Recognition as '2022-23 PNGAS Guard-Friendly School'

- Lock Haven, Bloomsburg, and Mansfield have been named as "PNGAS Guard-Friendly School" by the Pennsylvania National Guard Associations (PNGAS). Bloomsburg also received the 2022 PNGAS College/University of the Year designation.
- Criteria includes flexible scheduling options for National Guard members, providing credit for prior learning via military training and experience in accordance with American Council on Education college credit recommendations, and training for school faculty and/or staff on how to support the specific needs of military and veteran students, and permits recruiting by the Pennsylvania National Guard.



Forensics Team Extends Winning Streak

- The Bloomsburg Forensics team won the First Place Sweepstakes trophy at the Collegiate Forensic Association Fall Tournament in Bloomsburg as well as the Collegiate Forensic Association Tournament held in Ottawa, Canada.
- This marks the seventh consecutive tournament where BU has won the first-place team award.
- Dr. Neil Strine is the team advisor.



Lock Haven Women's Cross Country Team Earns Trip to NCAA National Championships

- Behind a pair of top-10 individual finishes, the Lock Haven women's cross country team placed third at the 2022 NCAA Division II Atlantic Region Championship, hosted by Mansfield, and earned a trip to the NCAA Division II Championship meet.
- The third-place finish is the highest regional team finish since the Bald Eagles placed second in 2011.



Bloomsburg Men's Soccer Team Finish as PSAC Runner-up

- The Bloomsburg men's soccer team hosted the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference final four for the first time in school history. The Huskies earned the No. 1 East seed after finishing the regular season 13-4-1 and 8-3-1 in conference play.
- BU fell to the second-ranked West seed, Mercyhurst, 1-0, in the championship.



Students Attend Research Conference

- Four CU students presented their work at the Council of Public Liberal Arts Colleges Northeast Regional Undergraduate Research, Scholarly and Creative Activity Conference.
- The students, two from Bloomsburg and two from Mansfield, representing four departments (art, biology, chemistry, and English), presented their scholarly and creative activity.
- Alan Bennett, a faculty member in the art department at Mansfield, accompanied the students to the conference.



Mansfield Dietetic Association Teaches Life Skills to Girl Scouts

- The Mansfield Student Dietetic Association recently held a taco night with a local Girl Scout Troop to teach them about the five food groups, as well as safe knife and kitchen skills.
- Together, the group cooked beef tacos, Spanish rice, and a peach salsa.




