BLOOMSBURG — A Bloomsburg University graduate has donated \$7 million — the largest donation to ever benefit educational needs — to Commonwealth University.

Stephen Jones graduated in 1983 and said his success as a lawyer and businessman began at BU.

The donation will benefit Commonwealth University's honors program on all three campuses. Each campus honors college program will also now be named in honor of his late mother, Eilleen C. Jones. She pushed him to pursue a degree after high school.

Jones said he and his brother were the first in his family to go to college — a trait he sees in students attending Commonwealth University today.

- The event brought together a diverse array of educators, administrators and aspiring teachers.




Health Professions Students Discover Jamaican Service Trip Rewarding On Many Levels


