- Regulations are in effect 24 hours a day and 365 days a year.
- Appeals received more than 10 days after issuance of parking ticket will not be accepted.

Appeal Instructions:

- Fully explain your reason for appeal. The appeal is based upon facts that you provide. Attach the ticket, and copies of any available documentation directly related to the appeal.
- Appeals are based upon legal elements. Personal disagreement with a rule or regulation is not cause for appeal.
- <u>Previous outstanding unpaid parking tickets must be settled before you can appeal subsequently issued tickets</u>.
- Once a decision has been made, you will be notified by mail.
- If more information is necessary, or if you desire to speak with the Chief of Police, please contact our office at 570-662-4900 to schedule an appointment.
- **Payment in full, by check, must be submitted for each ticket that is appealed.** If your appeal is granted, your check will be returned to you.

- · (Illegal) use of parking space inconvenienced no one, even if usage was short in duration
- Running late for appointment, work, class, etc.
- · Unable to leave work, class, etc., to move vehicle in a timed space
- Failure to see properly posted parking signage or painted curbs
- Failure to purchase (or renew, upon expiration) University parking permits
- · Financial hardship
- · Inclement weather

If you appeal a parking ticket the payment due date is temporarily placed on hold pending the outcome of the review.
