Artwork and Submission Guidelines

Deadline for online submission of work: Friday, December 12, 2025.

Artwork and Eligibility

Open to all current Commonwealth University of Pennsylvania students on Bloomsburg, Lock Haven, and Mansfield campuses.

All 2-D, 3-D, Graphic Design, and Motion-based media are eligible. Work must have been done during your time at Commonwealth University, and that has not been exhibited in the Loomis Gallery before this exhibition.

There is a submission limit of 3 pieces per student.

No work containing living or short-duration perishable materials will be accepted, i.e., plants, foodstuffs, etc.

Digital work that is motion-based or animated must be saved in MP4 format.

2-D and Graphic Design work should not exceed 48 inches in any direction or 80 lbs.

3-D work should not exceed 48 inches in any direction.

How it Works

All work is to be submitted by December 12, 2025, at midnight, and will be juried by their digital image for inclusion into the exhibition by an outside juror.

Artists will be notified by email if their work is accepted by Sunday, December 21, 2025.

Artists who are accepted will then be required to prepare their work for presentation over the remainder of the winter break.

2-D works are to be matted, framed, and 'ready to hang' with either hanging wire or other alternate form of professional presentation. If an alternate form of hanging is required, hanging materials must be provided with your submission of work along with a description on how to hang/present the work for exhibition. Consult your major professor if you need assistance.

3-D artworks should be prepared/cleaned for presentation and ready to stand or display on their own.

The juror will then decide upon the placement award winners in person once the exhibition is installed.

Video entries may be larger in size and should be in MP4 format. Please attach these through the OneDrive option in the email. Please contact Kenneth Cobb if you have issues uploading videos.

Dropoff of work: January 26-29, 8 am -5 pm.

Accepted artwork is to be delivered to the Loomis Gallery during the first week of classes, January 26-29, for installation.

The exhibition will run from February 2 – 26, 2026.

At the end of the exhibition, Artists will be required to pick up their artwork by 4 pm, Friday, February 27, 2026, or after the Closing Reception on Thursday, February 26, at 8 pm.

Loomis Gallery also receives a commission of 20% if a work sells, so make sure to mark your prices accordingly.

Loomis Gallery is open to the public, and visitors are allowed to take cameras into the gallery.
