COMMONWEALTH UNIVERSITY APPLICATION:

- Submit your application via commonwealthu.edu/apply
 - Declare your major as *Nursing ASN - LPN License Holders Study Option*
- If you have not completed all the prerequisite courses, you will need to apply to the traditional ASN Nursing Program and take the TEAS exam.
- If you are a current CU student, please complete the "Internal Transfer" Application located on the ASN web page.



OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS: Submit all official transcripts from other schools you have attended-high school, LPN school, college, etc. to the admissions office. Submit your LPN License, must be active unencumbered.



MUST HAVE COMPLETED ALGEBRA, BIOLOGY & CHEMISTRY W/LAB

Completed A, B, C's with a minimum required grade of C or higher.

MUST HAVE A 2.7 GPA OR HIGHER. Must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.7 or above.



COMPLETED PREREQUISITE COURSES: *Your transcripts will be reviewed to verify what courses must be completed prior to applying to the nursing program. Completed all prerequisite courses with minimum required grade of C or higher. Must maintain a 2.7 GPA. All prerequisites must be completed by the end of Spring Semester for Fall admission.*

COMPLETE THE LPN TO RN ADVANCED PLACEMENT NACE ASSESSMENT PACKAGE.

- *If all prerequisite coursework has been completed, applicants will receive "The Ticket to Test" to allow you to register for the LPN to RN Advanced Placement NACE Package that you will use to help you prepare for and to take the exams required to test out of the first year.

The program application deadline must be submitted by **March 1** for consideration into the LPN Advanced Placement to start in the following Fall semester. You will be notified by Mid-March, of the CU Nursing Admissions Committee's decision.

****Admission to the Nursing program is competitive. There are more qualified applicants applying to the program than there are seats available. Those interested in the nursing program should meet with an advisor early to review the criteria and clarify the process. It is important to note that meeting the minimum admission requirements does not guarantee acceptance to the program**
