 - Dr. Osgood: Today marks my 90th day as president here. It's been great, chaotic, and we are making great progress. I want to get some feedback from you today. We are moving Fall Commencement back on all campuses. We are also hearing your dissatisfaction with the lack of face-

to-face courses. We will be trying to aid this for next fall, but there is not much we can do about it here. There are many reasons as to why this is the case. My goal in the next 5 months is to figure out the revenue problem we have at CU. We are spending 10 million dollars, and we are running out of reserves. Within the next 2 years we will run out of reserves; however, I am working diligently to restore the funding to CU since it was cutback during integration. Our best estimate is in 27-28 academic year; we hope to lower the deficit to 5.5million. If we get the revenue restored, that would leave us with 4.5 million. We could build back our reserves and fix our facilities across the 3 campuses. For example, North Hall's roof would cost 8 million dollars. My goal is to be here as much as I can. There are 3 campuses, and they are not very close. But I would love to hear from you. Mansfield is absolutely a part of our plans here at Commonwealth University. We have many plans to renovate North Hall. In order to do that, we would have to get rid of other buildings to lower Operational costs. One of my first nights I attended the PRISM concert, and I would think those facilities need renovation as well. I want to know the priorities of the students. Just know that the money has to come from somewhere.
