- Weekly Private Lessons APMU2XX/3XX/4XX
  - APMU2XX reserved for those studying SECONDARY instruments or voice 30-minute weekly lessons, no studio class
  - APMU3XX weekly 30-minute private lessons for most music majors + weekly studio class
  - **APMU4XX** weekly 60-minute private lessons for **performance majors** + weekly studio class
  - o All private lessons will be individually scheduled with your studio teacher
  - Weekly Studio Class (sometimes referred to as "masterclass") **Tuesdays**, **1:00-1:50** (for most of you) meet with your studio professor and all students in your studio
- MUSI100 Recital Attendance
  - Weekly Promenade (Student recital) Thursdays, 1:00-1:50 in Steadman Theater
  - Required to attend at least 75% of all Promenade performances. You MUST scan in to be considered "in attendance"

  - WRIT103 Foundations in Composition
  - ENGL151 Introduction to Literature or any course approved for the Literature block of the general education curriculum
- Music ensembles can be taken for 1 or 0 credit. You MUST take one major ensemble each semester for 1 credit. Any ensembles that put you over 18 can be taken for 0 credit. Always register for ensembles FOR 1 CREDIT up to your limit of 18 credits.

### 5. MUSIC ED CLEARANCES – GET THESE STARTED NOW

- TB/TINE test can be done on campus at start of school, or at your local doctor
- FINGERPRINTING can also be done on campus (MUST be done in PA) MUST complete registration online before getting fingerprints
- 6. Piano Skills/Theory Skills what you can work on now.
  - a. Theory skills to be best prepared for the first day of class:
    - i. Letter names of the lines and spaces on the Grand Staff (treble & bass clef staves)
    - ii. Major & Minor ( all three forms) scale patterns
    - iii. Major & Minor key signatures
    - iv. Intervals (M2, m2, M3, m3, P4, P5, etc. . . and augmented and diminished intervals)
    - v. Building/recognizing triads (3-note chords) and 7th (4-note) chords
    - vi. Recognize and perform a variety of rhythms
      - In
    - vii. A variety of meters
  - b. Piano knowledge
  - c. Piano knowledge & skills to be best prepared for the first day of class see handout
- 7. Singing Skills if you don't regularly use your voice to make music, START NOW
- 8. Ensemble Auditions for Fall placement materials will be available online at <u>music.mansfield.edu/student-resources.cfm</u>
  - Prepare the etudes
  - Prepare at least all major scales
  - Some sight reading
- 9. Rule on ensemble participation for Freshmen limited to 2 large ensembles in first semester
- 10. Continuation policy:
  - A grade of "C, or better" needed to move on in sequenced curriculum (theory, class piano, music history)
  - A grade of "C, or better" needed for a music course to count towards a music degree
- 11. Top Ten Tips for Success
  - Go to class
  - Be engaged
  - Turn in assignments on time and take all exams and quizzes
  - Practice every day on your primary instrument. Consult with your private lesson instructor as to their expectations for your commitment to practice. Plan on committing to *at least* 45-60 each day.
  - Practice every day on secondary instruments at least 15 minutes per instrument
  - Sit in the front of class and look interested
  - Take notes (by hand) and type them up every night!
  - Take advantage of every opportunity (concerts, guest artists, special sessions, tutors, office hours)
  - Be inquisitive
  - Take/Learn from the best in others
