#### **English Professor Appears Web Program**

Jerry Wemple, professor of English, appeared on the July 14 edition of "WANA Live," the weekly reading series of the Writers Association of Northern Appalachia. The program is hosted by professors Damian Dressick of Slippery Rock University and Christina Fisanick of California University. The Association focuses on work by poets and writers of the sections of West Virginia, Ohio, New York, and Pennsylvania that are recognized as part of Appalachia. Wemple, the author of three poetry collections, read from his latest book as well as new poems from a manuscript-in-progress. The program was live streamed on Facebook and YouTube.

#### LHU Geology Professor Speaks on Oceanography and Environmental Issues

Professor Md. Khalequzzaman recently finished teaching a three-week long research-based coastal oceanography class in Wallops Island, Va. He spoke on the subject during the 18th training course on "Oceanography: Principles and Applications" organized by the National Oceanographic And Maritime Institute (NOAMI) on July 23 and delivered another lecture at the Ross Public Library on Environmental Issues of World Oceans on the same day. In addition, he co-authored a book chapter on Future Floods in Brahmaputra River Basic, which has been accepted for publication.

## **Commonwealth University Academic and Administrative Office Hours**
