CURRENT PROJECTS

Quantifying Sensory Processing and Neurodevelopmental Behavior in *Cipangopaludina* After Antipsychotic Treatment with Apiprioal 🐌

Overview:

Following up on previous lab research into pharmaceutical effects on Japanese trap snails. I propose shifting our focus from reproductive behavior to acute behavioral and sensorimotor positioning, like moving in and out of a shell due to stimuli. We could plan to evaluate how aquatic exposure to common antipsychotic compounds (ex., D2 antagonists like Haloperidol) alters the defensive reflexes and other feeding behavior. Dopamine and serotonin mediate neural circuits controlling withdrawal, habituation, and foot extension in rats and humans; assessing retraction provides a clear view of neurodevelopmental and sensorimotor movements.

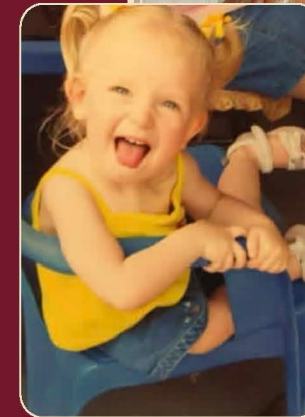
